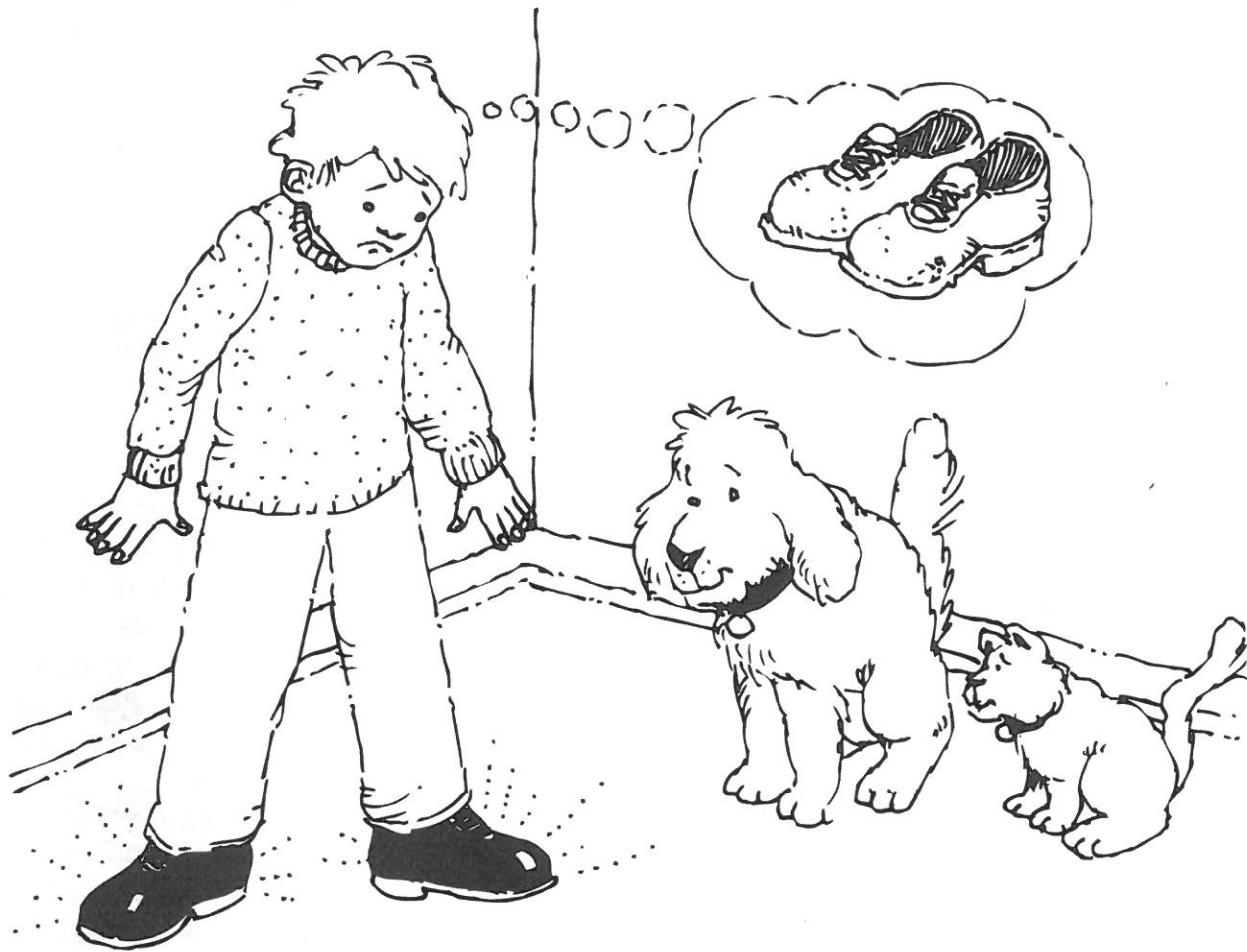

# New Shoes

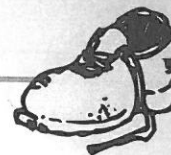


My shoes are new and squeaky shoes,
