## MELODIES M SECTION I

## To be used with Section I of all other chapters

The first melodies emphasize the basic aspects of tonality. They are designed to include easily recognizable scale and chordal patterns. These diatonic melodies are based on both major and minor modes.

The phrases are usually symmetrical and short

enough to be grasped at a glance. However, the diversity of rhythms, keys, modes, tempos, denamics, and clefs should provide a variety of musical experiences. The alto clef is introduced in exercise 33b; the minor mode in 47; compound meter § in 59c.
